## **Cyclists Make a Difference for Hospitalized Children**

New Haven, Connecticut -- April 23, 2010 -- On Saturday, May 29 and Sunday, May 30 of Memorial Day Weekend 2010, more than 200 cyclists are expected to participate in AngelRide – the annual two-day, 135-mile cycling event across the state.

Now in its seventh year, AngelRide is the only cross-state cycling event in Connecticut. The AngelRiders will be supported throughout the route by a motorcycle support team, mobile biketech specialists and hundreds of additional volunteers. Day One of AngelRide will take riders through 85 miles of scenic countryside to The Hole in the Wall Gang Camp's world-renowned camping facility for seriously ill children in Ashford, Connecticut. On Saturday night, AngelRide cyclists will enjoy an overnight stay at the Camp. On Day Two, the ride proceeds 50 miles to a celebratory finish in historic Mystic. A shorter children's ride is also scheduled for Day Two.

Organized by Team Hole in the Wall, AngelRide supports The Hole in the Wall Gang Camp's Hospital Outreach Program that brings the hope and healing of the Camp to the bedsides of seriously ill children in hospitals across the northeast. Each adult AngelRider commits to raising a minimum of \$1,000, 100% of which goes to sponsor the Camp's Hospital Outreach Program.
