Cyclists Ride for Seriously III Children

New Haven, Connecticut – May 30, 2010 – 312 cyclists completed the 132-mile AngelRide 2010 cross-state charity bike ride held May 29-30. Riders included 188 cyclists who took part in the two-day ride from Norfolk to Mystic, 77 Sunday-only riders and 47 children who rode a portion of the ride on Sunday from Ashford to Mystic. More than \$300,000 was raised through the ride to benefit The Hole in the Wall Gang Camp and its Hospital Outreach Program that brings the joy and healing of Camp to seriously ill children in hospitals across the northeast. The program seeks to improve the quality of life for hospitalized youngsters with cancer, sickle cell anemia, HIV/AIDS and other life-threatening illnesses through activities such as painting, crafts, games and companionship.

The riders were supported by 250 volunteers, including a motorcycle support team, mobile biketech specialists and dozens of additional volunteers. A Team Hole in the Wall event, AngelRide is named after Angela "Angel" Uihlein, who was diagnosed with leukemia in 2002, at the age of 11. Now at the age of 18, she is cancer-free and actively participates in AngelRide every year. AngelRide sponsors include the Fusco Corporation, Mohegan Sun and Poland Spring.
