Dear friends,

Although I wish we could all be celebrating our annual Fandango Benefit Gala at Camp, I am grateful that we are able to unite our hearts from the safety of our homes in support of our brave children and their families. Thank you for joining this year's virtual Gala celebration!

Our Founder Paul Newman knew that in order to provide "a different kind of healing" to seriously ill children and their families, other friends would need to step forward and make his dream their own. Thankfully, they did – you did – and continue to do so. During that first summer in 1988, we served 288 campers. Last year, Hole in the Wall provided year-round programming to more than 20,000 children and family members throughout the Northeast and mid-Atlantic – all free of charge. Thanks to a growing community of support, our services have expanded beyond residential summer camp sessions and family weekends. Camp's Hospital Outreach program now delivers daily doses of fun and friendship to hospitalized children and their families in more than 40 locations. And our Family Outreach program provides more frequent Camp connections through home visits, regional events and parent retreats.

Hole in the Wall is no stranger to trying new things, and that innovative spirit has served us well in recent months. Amid the pandemic, Hole in the Wall has pivoted with a purpose, shifting all residential and outreach programs to virtual and alternative expressions. We've laughed with our families in their living rooms during virtual Family Weekends and home visits. Parents have connected with one other and found support during weekly Caregiver Cabin Chats on Zoom. Camp's Hospital Outreach team has been providing virtual bedside visits and group activities while also producing a library of engaging videos to keep children entertained in our partner hospitals. And just last month, we concluded our 33rd summer, where 550 campers chose their own adventure from a mailing series, virtual weeklong Camp sessions or a special interest club.

At a time when we have all been experiencing fear, isolation and uncertainty, we are gaining a clearer understanding of the challenges seriously ill children and their families face every single day. And these times are especially challenging for those in our care, as they experience even more isolation and anxiety than usual due to heightened concerns caused by the pandemic.

This year's Gala is – like all Galas before – a celebration of the resilience of those who we are so privileged to serve. But this year's Gala is also something else – it is a reminder that Camp is everywhere. It is not just a place – it is a spirit, a community and a way of being. And for our children and families, it is also a lifeline of love, hope and healing. That's why the show must go on. And, because of the gift of your friendship, it will.

Thank you for opening your heart to Hole in the Wall.

Who's Who - Our Campers

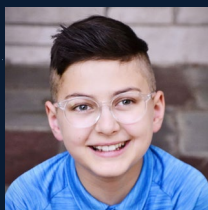


Connor

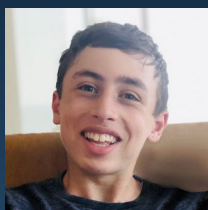
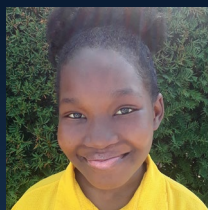


Drew

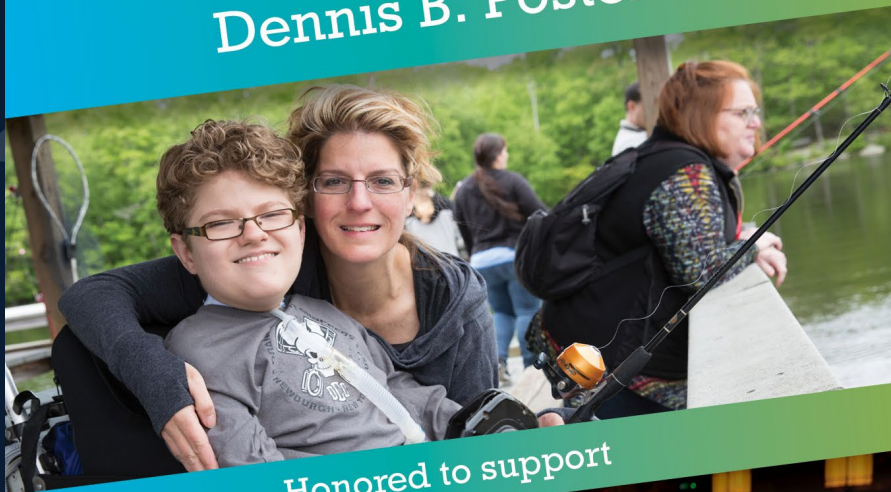
