Infirmery Support Job Description

Job Requirements:

- 18 years of age
- As of January 1, 2023, staff & volunteers within Summer 2023 programming are **required have the primary series AND one booster dose (bivalent) received after September 1, 2022***, to prevent against COVID-19.
- Physically and mentally capable of handling the care of campers.
- Be familiar with and enforce all safety, emergency, and camp policies.
- Serve as a role model and provide support to Camp volunteers.
- Commitment to foster a community that celebrates inclusivity and our camp values, which are inclusion, gratitude, possibility, friendship and safety.
- Be flexible with the changing needs of the program.
- The ability to work with a diverse community in a multicultural environment.
- Perform other duties as deemed necessary by Camp leadership.
- Self-motivated and directed, strong communication skills required.
- All positions are residential and are hired for the duration of our summer program. The time commitment is beginning of June to end of August.
- Comply with and remain flexible with COVID-19 specific precautions and requirements through the duration of the program, as outlined/advised by the CDC and HITWGC Medical Team.

Job Summary

The Infirmery Support staff will be an integral member of the Medical Team. Working alongside our Medical Team, this role will support the clerical and administrative functions to ensure efficient operations of the Infirmery. The Infirmery Support staff will maintain an organized, welcoming waiting area that offers games, toys and other activities to Campers, work to ensure all office and medical supplies are stocked and assist with a variety of other tasks to support the Infirmery.

Job Responsibilities:

- Serve as clerical support for Infirmery operations.
- Work to ensure that the Infirmery is kept clean, organized, and fully stocked with office and medical supplies across its various functional spaces.

- Maintain a clean and welcoming waiting area that offers games, toys, and other activities to campers. Work with Program Team to arrange, gather, and return items whenever necessary.
- Prepare the Infirmary for check-in & closing days, including the set-up of all check-in locations (i.e. ensuring necessary work surfaces, seating, and other related materials and supplies).
- Welcome camper walk-ins, bringing them to treatment room & notifying appropriate medical team members.
- Maintain camp standards of confidentiality with regard to camper medical records.
- Support, model, and participate in covid safety protocols and procedures including mask wearing, appropriate distancing, handwashing, etc.

The Infirmary Support Staff directly reports to the Medical Team Administrative Assistant.
