Seasonal Gardener Job Description

Job Requirements

- The ability to work independently.
- General knowledge of methods of gardening/landscaping.
- Knowledge of use and care of motorized equipment and hand/power tools used in grounds maintenance work.
- Organizational and time management skills.
- Be flexible with the changing needs of the program.
- Ability to work outdoors in varied weather conditions, traverse varied terrain, and lift and carry materials up to 50 pounds.
- Communicate clearly with Lead Groundskeeper and other team members.
- Reach, bend and stoop frequently.
- Work in a standing and/or bending position for long periods of time.
- Valid driver's license and driving record which meets HITWGC insurance carrier requirements. Ability to drive to assigned worksites.
- Subject to a Criminal Background check.
- All positions are seasonal and are hired nominally from mid-April to late mid-September, 20 hours/week.

Job Summary

The Seasonal Gardener assists with the gardening/landscaping duties of the facilities and ground areas as assigned by the Lead Groundskeeper.

Job Responsibilities

- Perform basic maintenance of gardens such as watering, managing weed control, pruning and raking.
- Plant and nurture new trees, flowers and various plants/shrubs.
- Work with hand tools and basic light machinery.
- Assists with special projects and performs additional duties as assigned.
- Be responsible for knowing and adhering to policies and procedures contained in the Camp manual.
- Demonstrates the core values of the organization: Safety, Camaraderie, Possibility and Appreciation.

The Seasonal Gardener reports directly to the Lead Groundskeeper.
