Night Nurse

Job Requirements:

- Registered Nursing Degree (BSN preferred).
- Current Connecticut RN license (prior to arrival at Camp).
- Current CPR certification.
- Current PALS (Pediatric Advanced Life Support) certification.
- 18 years of age.
- All staff are required to have received the COVID-19 vaccine and be fully vaccinated prior to commencing employment.
- Physically and mentally capable to handle the care of campers.
- Be familiar with and enforce all safety, emergency, and camp policies.
- Serve as a role model and provide support to Camp volunteers.
- Commitment to foster a community that celebrates inclusivity and our camp values, which are inclusion, gratitude, possibility, friendship and safety.
- Be flexible with the changing needs of the program.
- The ability to work with a diverse community in a multicultural environment.
- Perform other duties as deemed necessary by Camp leadership.
- Comply with and remain flexible with COVID-19 specific precautions and requirements through the duration of the program, as outlined/advised by the CDC and HITWGC Medical Team.
- All positions are residential and are hired for the duration of our summer program. The time commitment is mid-June to mid-August.
- Pediatric hematology/oncology, inpatient, and pediatric emergency experience is valued.

Job Summary

The night nurse is responsible for nursing care of all campers in the overnight hours. The overnight nurse provides all nursing care to campers scheduled to sleep in our "Moose Lodge"- housing designated for campers that require overnight nursing care. The night nurse also serves as "first call and triage" for any walk-in or urgent needs overnight, both for campers and staff. The Moose Lodge typically houses 3-4 campers during our general sessions. Any campers admitted to our infirmary for inpatient care will be cared for by the

night nurse during the overnight hours. This position requires strong inpatient nursing skills, confidence, communication skills, and independence. A backup nurse and on call MD are available at all times to the Night Nurse, both for phone support and in person support as needed.

Job Responsibilities:

- Provide nursing care to campers aged 7-15 in the traditional summer program. This includes medication administration (PO, GT/JT, SQ, inhaled and topical), procedures (IV placement, blood draw, wound care, etc.), assistance with ADLs, and emergency care.
- Responsible for the care of Moose Lodge campers, inpatient campers, and walk-ins overnight (8pm-8am).
- The night nurse will communicate with day staff prior to and following each shift to ensure proper continuity of care.
- Serve as a role model and provide support to infirmary volunteers.
- Support, model, and participate in COVID safety protocols and procedures including mask wearing, appropriate distancing, handwashing, etc.
- Participate in camper COVID response protocols including screening, testing, transporting, and caring for camper under investigation or with confirmed covid-19.

Reports to:

The Night Nurse directly reports to the Director of Nursing and Clinical Operations.
