Job Description

Job Requirements

- Undergraduate studies with a focus in Nutritional Sciences, Dietetics, or associated background: 2 completed years preferred.
- Foodservice experience and/or ServSafe Certification preferred.
- Strong communication skills.
- Self motivated and directed.
- Dietary Interns are required to live on camp from June through August.
- Dietary Interns work under the supervision of the Nursing Director.

Job Summary

The two dietary interns will work together to provide safe, nutritious, and appropriate meals to campers with severe allergies and medical dietary needs. Diagnoses we serve include campers with metabolic and mitochondrial disorders, PKU, diabetes, and multiple severe food allergies. Our year-round Registered Dietitian Consultant will provide support to the dietary interns and will provide meal planning for protein-restricted campers. The dietary interns will plan, cook, and provide meals and snacks for all campers with severe and less severe dietary needs. The dietary interns will act as a resource and support for all summer camp programs.

Job Responsibilities

- Collaborate with Staff Nurses and Registered Dietitian Consultant to ensure the dietary needs of the campers are safely met.
- Collaborate with Registered Dietitian Consultant to create meal plans with camper parents/guardians prior to camper arrival.
- Communicate supply and ingredient needs to Head Chef prior to camper arrival.
- Provide education and support to Cabin and Program Counselors with regards to campers' dietary needs.
- Prepare and serve meals in a timely manner for campers and staff with significant dietary needs including but not limited to severe food allergies, PKU, tyrosinemia, fatty oxidation disorders, diabetes, etc.
- Plan and prepare safe snack bins for all campers as well as options for campers with significant dietary needs.
- Meet with camper parents/guardians on opening day to ensure meal plan and collect camper meal supplies.
- Maintain campers' personal food in an organized and sanitary manner.
- Provide education and support to Cabin and Program Counselors with regards to campers' dietary needs.
- Monitor and document camper Phenylalanine, fat, carb, etc. intake as made necessary.
- Maintain cleanliness and sanitation of meal preparation area.
- Maintain camp standards of confidentiality with regard to camper medical records.
- Know and adhere to policies in the staff manual.
- Perform additional duties as deemed necessary by Nursing Director, Head Chef, and Camp Director.

Reports to:

- The dietary intern is directly responsible to the nursing director.
