Night Nurse Job Description

Iob Requirements

- Registered Nursing Degree (BSN preferred).
- Current Connecticut RN license (prior to arrival at Camp).
- Current CPR certification.
- Current PALS (Pediatric Advanced Life Support) certification.
- Commitment to foster a community that celebrates inclusivity and our camp values, which include camaraderie, appreciation, possibility and safety.
- All positions are residential and are hired for the duration of our summer program. The time commitment is from the end of May to late August.
- Pediatric hematology/oncology, inpatient, and pediatric emergency experience preferred.
- Previous camp experience preferred.

Job Summary

The night nurse is responsible for nursing care of all campers in the overnight hours. The overnight nurse provides all nursing care to campers scheduled to sleep in our "Moose Lodge"- housing designated for camper that require overnight nursing care. The night nurse also serves as "first call and triage" for any walk-in or urgent needs overnight, both for campers and staff. The Moose Lodge typically houses 3-4 campers during our general sessions. Any campers admitted to our infirmary for inpatient care will be cared for by the night nurse during the overnight hours. This position requires strong inpatient nursing skills, confidence, communication skills, and independence.

<u>Job Responsibilities</u>

- Provide primary nursing care to campers age 7-15 in the traditional summer program during the
 nighttime hours. This includes medication administration (PO, GT/JT, IV, SQ, inhaled, and topical),
 procedures (IV placement, wound care, etc), assistance with ADLs, respiratory support, and emergency
 care.
- Responsible for the care of Moose Lodge campers, inpatient campers, and walk-ins overnight (8pm-8am).
- The night nurse will communicate with day staff prior to and following each shift to ensure proper continuity of care.
- Be familiar with and enforce all safety, emergency and camp policies.
- Serve as a role model and provide support to infirmary volunteers.
- Perform other duties as deemed necessary by Camp leadership.

Reports to:

• The night nurse is directly responsible to the nursing director.
