## **Space & Aviation Day Makes for Free Family Fun**

New Haven, Conn., July 1, 2010 – Family fun takes center stage at Space & Aviation Day hosted by Bradley Family Day, Inc. on Saturday, August 14, 2010 from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. at Bradley International Airport in Windsor Locks as well as The New England Air Museum (located at 36 Perimeter Road at Bradley Airport) and the Bradley Air National Guard Base (located at 100 Nicholson Road in East Granby). Now in its eleventh year, this free event attracts thousands of attendees with static aircraft displays, live demonstrations, space exploration activities, music, entertainment, games, contests and more. The Space Race 5K is held at 8am. Event proceeds benefit Connecticut's own Hole in the Wall Gang Camp founded by Paul Newman to support children with serious illnesses. Parking is free and free shuttle buses are available to visit the three clustered venues.

The Space Race 5K is held on the runway at the Air National Guard Base when runners feel the exciting rumble of departing aircraft as they run.
